The Plum Creek Conservation District mitigation plan involves a process of eight (8) phases which are (1) Pre-Qualification, (2) Well Examination, (3) Data Compilation, (4) Mitigation Meeting, (5) Board Report, (6) Rehearing Request, (7) Final Board Ruling, and (8) Compliance
